Rosie has two cats and a dog. She loves her pets.



Anko is the tall friendly cat. She loves when you rub her belly.

Rosie has been home for a while. When she asked her mom why she was not allowed to play with her friends or go to school, her mom mentioned they are in a LOCKDOWN.




# Lockdown



**Mommy,

A virus called “**COVID-19**” is spreading all over the world via human interaction. We are all asked to stay home.


When we stay home we help our family, friends and teachers stay safe.

That is my school which is locked down.






Germs can get into the air when we cough and sneeze.

**How do I wear my Mask ?**





It's easy to wear a mask Rosie.

**FIRST**, make sure your hands are clean.



**SECOND**, Hold the mask by the strings and wear it by your ears






**Rosie, Here is how you take your  
mask off**


**FIRST**, take the strings off your ears.




Whenever you go out of the house, you should wear a mask:

Remember anytime you are out of the house you should wear a mask!








## **Never do the following with your mask**

Most importantly do not pull mask down your chin. It should always be worn.


So remember, before putting on the mask and after removing the mask, the simple thing to do is, **wash your hands.**







are not be required to wear masks.










Mommy, are masks

Masks are for kids and adults.








